This position reports to the Theatrical & CORE Manager.

Responsibilities:

- Unbox, assemble, install, address and focus new theatrical fixtures.
- Assist in the programming and commissioning of ETC, Pathway, Strand, CK, Traxon, Lumenpulse and/or Pharos/Mosaic lighting systems.
- Complete drawing analysis and takeoffs for jobs being estimated or quoted.
- Assist the service team with troubleshooting existing systems.
- Assist with data entry into our corporate accounting and project management software to ensure proper documentation and records for ongoing projects.
- Assist with design/build jobs (lighting control system design).
